

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **START TIMES**

All **Club and Club aggregate games** commence at 7:30pm, to be included in the draw please ensure that you arrive at the hall by 7:15pm.

**Competition games** commence at 7:00pm, please be at the hall by 6:45pm. To be included in the draw please ensure that you have registered your name on the notice board prior to the competition night.

**Members who are unable to make it to the hall before these times are requested to ring a committee member to ensure that they can be included in the draw.**

### **CLUB AGGREGATE**

Points are accumulated during the season to ascertain the leading Skip, Three, two and lead. Points are awarded as follows:

Each member of a winning team receives 3 points per game won.

Each member of a team where the game is drawn receives 2 points.

Each member of losing team receives 1 point per game lost.

Please note: SOME CHAMPIONSHIPS WILL ALSO ACCUMULATE AGGREGATE POINTS.

### **SENIOR/JUNIOR SINGLES**

Any club member can play in the senior singles competition but they forego the right to play in the junior singles in that same year.

When a player has won the Junior Singles Championship twice they are no longer eligible to compete for that title again

This however does not prevent them from playing in the junior pairs.

### **FEES**

Club fees are \$20.00 per season (due by the end of April) and \$2.00 per night mat fee.

Club members, if they wish, can opt to pay a yearly fee of \$60.00 to cover subs and mat fees.

Juniors (under 18yrs) to pay \$10.00 club fees plus mat fees \$1.00 per night.

**Only financial members will be eligible to play in any of the championship games.**

## SMOKING

Our Lady of the Rosary School operates a strict no smoking policy, which we must adhere to all times. This means no smoking in any of the building or School grounds. Failure to comply with this policy could jeopardize our use of their facilities.

## GENERAL

Please assist the club by helping out where you can. If you can arrive early please assist with the setting up. Supper is normally after the second game so the first teams to finish should prepare the supper. Like wise the first teams finished at the end of the evening should do the supper dishes. If you are fit enough please assist with returning the hall to its original state ready for the school to use the next day.

## OBLIGATIONS OF PLAYERS

While a player has control of the playing area players at the bowling end must keep as clear as possible of the mat and the player's line of vision.

The Skip or players at the end opposite the bowling end must keep clear of the mat while a bowl is being bowled.

Players shall be allowed to bowl their bowls and Skips to issue their instructions without interference from their opponents or other persons. Unnecessary speaking is regarded as interference.

In team play all players must remain at the bowling end until it is the Skip's turn to play.

In singles each player must remain at the bowling end of the mat while their opponent has control of the playing area.

No player shall follow any bowl up the mat or up the side of the mat until it has come to rest.

Play in bare feet or jandals is not permitted

Coins should not be tossed to land on the mat

- **Lead** – tosses the coin to decide which team will bowl first, check with your skip what to do if you should win the toss. Gathers the bowls at the end of each end once the score has been agreed
- **Two** – Keeps the score, and confirms this and ends played with the opposition
- **Three** – Is the sole decider of the score in conjunction the opposing Three. No other players may at the 'head' during scoring.
- **Skip** – Has control of the team and his/her instructions must be complied with by team members
